

Title	Bridging Japanese and immigrant expectations for membership in Japanese society
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Abstract	Using the Keio Grant for the Development of Academic Research, my research about Social Markers of Acculturation ("SMA") has advanced in 2 ways: 1. I have given 6 presentations (3 at academic conferences and 3 invited lectures) to share my research results from 3 separate papers that I am developing about SMA, and 2. I have published one refereed paper in an international academic journal, am almost finished another, and have compiled all of the data necessary for 2 more papers. I am also working on a new edited volume, The SAGE Handbook of Intercultural Communication, that is contracted and will be published in early 2025. For #1 above, I gave presentations at 3 conferences (2 international and 1 in Japan). First, I gave the Presidential Research Address (as President of the organization) at the International Academy for Intercultural Research's 13th Biennial Conference. I also presented my research at the Japanese Studies Association of Australia's 2023 Conference and the SIETAR (Society for Intercultural Education, Training, and Research) Japan Annual Conference.
