- (a) Papers should be clearly typed on sturdy paper and double spaced. Two copies should be sent to the Editorial Committee of the Keio Economic Society, Keio University, 2-15-45 Mita, Minato-ku, Tokyo, Japan 108. The journal publishes articles in English in principle.
- (b) The first page of the paper should include:
 - (i) the title of the paper
 - (ii) an abstract with less than 100 words
 - (iii) the name and institutional affiliation of the author
- (c) Footnotes, especially those with complicated mathematical expressions, should be avoided as far as possible.
- (d) References should be indicated by a reference number in square brackets. They should be listed together at the end of the paper.
