- (a) Papers should be clearly typed on sturdy paper and double spaced. Three copies should be sent to the Editorial Committee of the Keio Economic Society, Keio University, 2-15-45 Mita, Minato-ku, Tokyo, Japan 108. The journal in principle publishes its articles in English.
- (b) The first page of the paper should include:
 - (i) the title of the paper
 - (ii) an abstract with less than 100 words
 - (iii) the name and institutional affiliation of the author
- (c) Footnotes, especially those with complicated mathematical expressions, should be avoided if at all possible.
- (d) Your paper may preferably be submitted to Keio Economic Studies on a personal computer disk, once the paper is accepted for publication. The paper on the disk should be accompanied by the corresponding printout. The acceptable storage medium is a 3.5 inch disk in MS-DOS or Macintosh format. Make absolutely sure that the file on the disk and the printout are identical. Please use a new correctly formatted disk and label this with your name; also specify the software (including the version number) and hardware used as well as the title of the file to be processed. The disk will not be used if it is hard to process. The submitted disk as well as the printout will not be returned to the author.
