The *Shobo-Gumi* in Rural Life

In this paper, I try to investigate a *shobo-gumi* (a fire brigade) in a Japanese village community (Minami-Majino, Nagano Prefecture). This paper deals primarily with the role of the *shobo-gumi* in the formation and change of the structure of the village community from the Meiji Era to the close of World War II.

I discuss mainly three problems:

- (1) how the *shobo-gumi* is organized
- (2) intergroup relations between the *shobo-gumi* and the other groups in a village community.
- (3) interdependences between the *shobo-gumi* and the village government by which it is established.
