英米法記事

慶應英米法研究会

はしがき

慶應英米法研究会が生れたのは昭和二年の終りに近い頃であつた。同會が成立するやうになつたのは、最初故佐原篤介氏などから是非英米法研究会のやうなものを組織してはどうかと云ふ熱心な勧めもあつたのであるが、なか／＼具體化するまでには進まなかつた。ところが、昭和二年の十月頃増島六一郎博士が好意的に博士の正求律書院を吾々の爲めに開放して下さると云ふ話があるが、段々實現されさうになつて來た。之に付ては前記佐原氏や義塾の及川恒忠教授などの御盡力のあつたことは云ふまでもない。次第に話は進行して遂に昭和二年十月二十三日、私は及川教授のお伴をして丸の内の事務所へ増島博士をお訪ねすることになつた。さうして、大體の話がほど纏つたのであるが、私はその翌日歐洲に旅立つことになつてゐたので、その後のことは總て及川教授の御盡力に依つて今日の研究会が具體的に成立することになつたのである。

研究会員は學生を主として成り立つてゐるのであるが、學校に於ける特別研究のほか、一週一回正求律書院に會して研究を續けてゐるのである。その際は必ず夕食を共にして極めて打解けた氣分で研究しようと思ふのである。この點が學校に於ける教場のムードなどと全く異り、非常によい効果を與へるやうに思はれる。他方に於ては簡單な會食ではあるが或る意味に於て例のテンプレのディナーよりも遙かに意味深いものがあるやうにも思はれる。

正求律書院では彌島保三郎氏が主として學生を指導せられて下さるのであるが、その熱心なる態度には吾々一同深く感謝の意

い^てを羨してをるものである。増島博士も會合には殆んど缺かさず出席せられ、所謂局式論法で各種の問題を論ぜられ吾々の案を低下させることは、吾々の大いに幸願せざるべきであるが、就中増島博士が吾々のために文庫を開放して下さつたその御好意に對しては、衷心より感謝をしてをる次第である。

兎に角右のやうな譯で、吾々の慶應英米後研究會(The Keio Common Law Society)は成立後日なほ淺いのであるから、今後は益々勢力し研究の歩を進め、進くとも著實の足取りで將來の「歩」を進め固めて行かねばならぬ。と同時に私は會員諸君の自費的な相互研究を奨進にして、たゞ教へらるゝせざるに進歩するばかりでなく、進んで自ら研究の分野を開拓し、この方面に於ても獨立自尊の精神を大いに發揚せられんことを望むものである。

今度研究會で英米法學界の記事や文獻などを紹介しようと思ふ金があるのを總會として、私は一言この研究會の成立の大體を紹介した次第である。

最後に、この研究會の成立に盡力して下さつた荏藤篤介氏が去る七月十七日滿洲に於て長逝せられたことは、洵に遺憾の至りである。去る八月十三日谷中清雄に於て骨別式が執行せられたものであるが、私も臨んでその靈前に最後のお別れをしたことであつた。この機會に研究會員と共に深く哀悼の意を表する。(英米後記)

【記事第一】

□ Justice Holmes vs Chief Judge Benjamin N. Cardozo. Holmes. 判事がアメリカ法學界のみならず廣く世界的にその名を知られてをることは、今更こゝに述べるまでもないことである。同判事は既に昨年その九十歳の誕辰を祝はれた程の高齡であるが、その學識と識見は正に他人の追従を許

らぬところであるのみならず、勇氣、公平、思想の自由の代表者として、幾多の危期に際しても、よくアメリカ國民の法律に對する尊敬心を維持して來たのである。その Holmes 判事がこの度來る間の司法官生活から退かれたのである。こゝに於て何人がその後を承けるかと云ふことは、アメリカは勿論その他の國の法曹會からも非常な興味を以て注視せられてゐたのであつたが、New York Court of Appeals の Chief Judge Benjamin N. Cardozo 氏がその後を承けつゝ Associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court に任命せらるゝことになつた。同氏の任命にはアメリカ國民も、アメリカ法曹界も等しく舉つて後任者として最適任者を得たることを喜んだのである。

Cardozo 判事の名聲は、夙にその裁判に於て現れてゐる。その裁判に現れたる氏の學識、適切巧妙なる手際などは確かに他の何人も及ぶべからざるものがある。氏の著書としては The Nature of Judicial Process; The Growth of the Law; Paradoxes of Legal Science がある。是等は何れも氏の學識、識見が如何に豊かであるかを知るに十分なるものとせらるゝのである。

さて、氏の任命はイギリス法曹會では特に如何なる觀察をしてをるであらうか。イギリス方面の見るところによると、氏がアメリカ最高法院に起用せられたることは、その結果として、當然アメリカ憲法問題に關する事件を取扱ふ場合が多くなるであらうから、從來同氏の主たる仕事であつた

ランモン・ローの問題に付て研究するの機会が少くなることは、聊か遺憾の念を禁じ得ないものと
