International Press Correspondence

における中國關係記事目録

— 1921年10月（創刊）～1927年7月 —

中國共產黨が、その創立にあたって、またそれ以後の時期における革命運動において、コミンテルン（Comintern）の強力な指導のもとにおかれていたということは、否定しえない事実である。もつとも、1935年1月の遵義會議で毛澤東の指導權が確立された頃から、その影響力はしだいに減少したように考えられるけれども、陳獨秀が黨の指導的地位を占めていた黨の創立および第一次國共合作の時期から、瞿秋白、李立三の時期を経てロシア留學生派の指導時期にいたるまで、コミンテルンの指導は、革命路線の轉換・決定から黨人事にまでおよぶ極めて強力かつ廣汎なものであり、これらの時期における中國共產黨の革命運動の性格とその展開は、コミンテルンとの關係の分析なしに理解することは不可能であるといわなければならないのである。それにもかかわらず、従来わが國でおこなわれていた中國共產黨史の研究においては、中國共產黨に對するコミンテルンのインパクトを分析し、その面から共產黨の革命路線の變遷および黨内問題を究明しようとする研究方向が極めて少なかったように思われるのである。その原因については、いろいろの理由が擧げられるであろうが、そのもつとも重要なものの一つは、わが國でコミンテルン關係の文書を入手することが容易でなかつたし、またこんにちこのような資料を容易に見えぬ、ということにあるといつて差支えないであろう。

わたくしは、かねてからこのコミンテルン關係資料の蒐集の必要を、中國共產黨史の研究との關連において強く感じていたところ、たまたま機會をえて1956年夏渡米し、その重要資料の一つである *International Press Correspondence* をマイクロフィルムで入手することができた。

周知のように、*International Press Correspondence* は、中國共產黨の革命運動に直接重要な影響をあたえたコミンテルン執行委員會の機關誌であり、創刊は1921年10月である。*International Press Correspondence* は英語版の名稱であり、1938年7月2日刊行の18卷33號から *World News and Views* という名稱に改められた。わたくしがもちかえり、現在慶應義塾大學圖書館におさめられているものは、1921年10月の創刊號から1950年までのものであり、缺號も存在するが、現在わが國で入手しうるもつとも完全なものではないかと考えられる。この中國關係記事目録は、この資料を基礎とし、

中國關係の記事・論文を収録したものであり（したがって當然中國問題に言及していることが明白なコミンテルン大會決議などは収録していない），できうれば1950年度まで逐次發表する機會をもちたいものと思つている。この目録が，最近しだいに中國共產黨とコミンテルンとの關係の研究に目を向けるようになったわが國の研究者に，少しでも役立ちうるならば，わたくしのこれに優る喜びはないのである。

なお，この目録作成にあつては，慶應義塾大學院三浦秀夫，小田英郎兩君の努力に負うところ多大であつた。記して感謝の意をあらわしたいと思う。
