わたくしは、かつて本誌第 32 卷 11 號に、創刊號（1921 年 10 月）から 1927 年 7 月までの International Press Correspondence に掲載された中國關係記事目録を發表したことがあるが、今回はそれにつづいて 1927 年 8 月から 1930 年 6 月までの分を發表することとした。

以前に發表したさいの序文で明らかにしたように、International Press Correspondence は、とくに黨の創立および第一次國共合作の時期から瞿秋白・李立三の時期を経てロシア留學生派の指導時期にいたるまで、中國共產黨の革命運動に直接重要な影響をあたえたコミンテルン執行委員會の機關誌であり、中國共產黨とコミンテルンとの關係を研究するためには不可欠の資料である。International Press Correspondence そのものについての解説、その中國關係記事目録のもつ意義などについては、以前すでに述べておいたのでここでは再述しないが、ともかく、この目録が最近したいに中國共產黨とコミンテルンの關係の研究に目をむけるようになったわが國の研究者に少しでも役立ちうるならば、これにまさる喜びはないのである。

なおこの目録作成にあたっては、法學修士（慶應義塾大學）・アジア經濟研究所所員徳田教之氏の努力に負うところが多大であつたことを、とくに附記しておきたい。今後もこのような目録をひきつづき發表する機會をもちたいものと考えている（石川）。
