「国際機構論」関係英文文献目録

松本三郎

解説

十七世紀にヨーロッパに成立した近代民族国家は、十八世紀後半に始まった産業革命と技術革新の洗礼を浴びつつ発展し、政治、経済生活における国際化を促進していった。このような政治的、経済的、社会生活の国際的展開は、やがてそれを調整し、円滑化するための国際機関の発生を必然化し、十九世紀後半に入ると一八六五年の国際電信連合にはじまる一連の国際的組織が次々と誕生した。

しかしながら、国際社会の円滑な運営にとって一層基本的な課題は「戦争と平和」の問題である。戦争のない平和な社会を樹立することは人類の悲願であり、ダンテ、ルッソー、カント等による永久平和の構想も、正にこの人類の歴史的願望を達成せんがためのものであった。

平和維持のための国際的機関がはじめて作られたのは、ナポレオン戦争後の欧州協調体制であり、以後第一次大戦後の国際連盟を経

て、第二次大戦後の国際連合へと、その規模、その内容を充実拡大させながら発展してきた。今日の国際社会が、依然として主権国家を基本的構成単位とし、国際政治が国家的利益の見地から推進されていることは否定しがたいが、国際社会の中に育くまれてつつある国際主義も益々その支持層を拡めつつある。第一義的には国際社会の安全を保障することを目的として設立された国際連合が、幾多の困難に直面しつつも、依然として、いや益々幅広く且つ強い支持を世界各国から得ているのは、国家主権を背景とする国家利益第一主義と、国際社会の調和を第一目的とする国際主義の二本の柱の上に立つ今日の世界の現実を如実に示すものといえよう。

さてこのように、われわれ人類は、第一には「戦争のない平和な国際社会を樹立するために」、第二には「増大する政治的、経済的、文化的国際交流を円滑且つ効果的に機能せしめるために」、種々の国際機構を創設し、発展させてきたが、このような国際組織を体系化し、分析を試みることによつて、その本質、機能を明らかにしよ

うとするのが、国際機構論 (International Organization) という専門である。

国際政治学そのものがきわめて新しい歴史をもつものであるが、国際機構論は更に歴史が新らしく、それが体系的に研究されはじめたのは、主として第二次大戦後のことといえよう。この学問の性格上、国際政治、国際法両分野を中心とする総合的研究が必要である。さて、戦後わが国においても、昭和二十六年東京大学教養学部国際関係論科に「国際機構論」の講座が設けられて以来、幾つかの大学においてその講座がもたれてきたが、未だその歴史も浅く、研究者の数も決して多くはない。また欧米における国際機構論に関する文献もわが国には充分に紹介されてきていないように思われるので、ここにその一部を紹介し、同学者の参考に供したいと思う。

さて、ここに紹介する「国際機構論」関係の主要英文文献は、アメリカのフレッチャ―国際関係大学院およびハーバード大学の教授で、国際法および国際機構論を専攻するレオ・グロス (Leo Gross) 教授が蒐集分類されたもの (一九六五年まで) を中心とし、一九六六年以後の国際連合関係主要英文図書 (雑誌論文は含まず) をとりあげ、Cumulative Book Index 等を参考として選出し、一括して最後尾に添録した。
