働きかけられて、以て物質的生産を發展せしめるその過程の研究が、歴史學であると考へられるのである。乍然敢えて誤解を招かんことを恐れて一言して置きたい。歴史學とは何であるかに就いて云ふ右の定義付けに見らるゝ物質的生産の發展過程の研究は、素より物質的生産といふもののみを切り離してその發展を追ふといふのではない。それは對自然及び對人間の相互作用といふところからして明かなるが如く、謂ゆる上部構造の發展過程も勿論含めるのであり、この發展過程と物質的生産發展過程とを一の全體的關聯の下に、即ち兩者を統一的全體として研究するの意味であることを附言し置くであらう。

幾多の岐路に踏み入りながら、爰に於いて本稿の課題は一應果されたものとする。勿論この最後に掲げたる定義付けと關聯して、歴史學と經濟史との關係の如き、或は生産力の發展の如き、更には既に一言せる發展段階の如きは、論及する必要最も緊切なるものに屬する。乍然これ等はすべて他の機會に述ぶるところありたいと思ふ。又本稿に於いて對象とせるクノオの有する經濟史觀に就いては、遂に言及するを得なかつたのであるが、この史觀の特徴の一としての、經濟發展が直線的のそれであり、從て歴史に於ける飛躍を認めぬ點に就いては、特に批判を加へねばならないと考へる。そしてこのことの必要さは、この史觀が當今可成り多くの人々によつて意識的に又は無意識的に採り用ゐられてゐることからしても、特に大であると云はねばならない。然しこの問題は、「發展」に就いての究明に際して論ずることを至當とするが故に、「發展」の論究を他日に期した今に於いては、この謂ゆる經濟的唯物論の批判も亦、同じく他日に於いてその場所を見出すといふ徑を辿るのである。
